

Richmond DPU: City Improvement Projects

Job: Lake Cherokee Forebay #4 Sediment Removal

Location: 4254 Cheyenne Road

Project Introduction

This project will remove the sediment from the forebay at 4254 Cheyenne Road to improve the function of the forebay.

Construction is anticipated to begin during the week of Tuesday, January 20, 2026, weather permitting. The project is expected to last approximately eight weeks, also weather permitting.

All activities associated with this project will occur at 4254 Cheyenne Road. Minor traffic impacts may occur along the the 4200 block of Cheyenne Road when construction equipment and materials are transported during the project. The project will have silent pumps active during sediment removal operations which may run 24 hours a day for a few days time. Silent pumps will be used for all pumping activities. The project area is indicated in red in the graphic below.

The project will have silent pumps active during sediment removal operations which may run 24 hours a day for a few days time. Silent pumps will be used for all pumping activities associated with the project.
